FACTS	WHAT INFORMATION LOUISIANA BAPTIST FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information.  Federal law gives consumer the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
WHAT?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:	
	Social Security number and income	
	Account balances and transaction history	
	Credit history and credit scores	
	When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.	
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Louisiana Baptist Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Louisiana Baptist Federal Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information.
How does Louisiana Baptist Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you  Open an account or apply for a loan  Show your government-issued ID or provide employment information  Make deposits or withdrawals from your account  We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only  Sharing for affiliates everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness  Affiliates from using your information to market to you  Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you  State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
